It happened slowly; adding one thing then another then another.

I fell into comparison; thinking busy was best.

I was disregarding my own personality, make up, capacity.

I wasn't taking a sabbath. A sabbath is not a suggestion but a command. Do not confuse sabbath with self-care. If you are to feel truly rested your soul must get rest and for your souls to get rest you must spend time with the Father. Focusing on yourself will give you momentary rest but not restorative rest. Also, sabbath is not hoarding your time (introverts). Isolating is not sabbath.

Be intentional to have a day of soul rest. Sometimes you have to get drastic - I quit my jobs and some ministries. There was much fear there but what I'm doing now is so life-giving.

Don't think God can't rearrange your schedule. If you're trying to honor Him, He will bless it.

I start open-handed because I haven't got a thing. I will squeeze the life out of me if I lead close-handed. I'll limit what I can steward if my hands are closed.

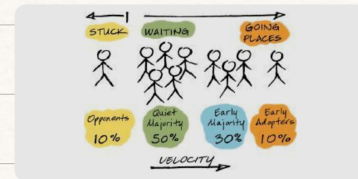
